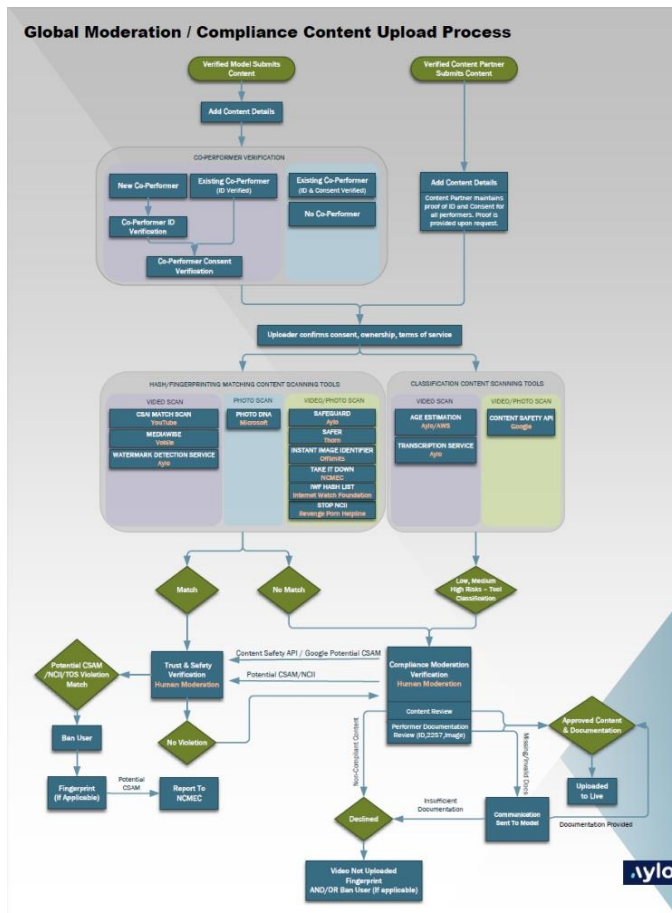


Tube8 - Semi-Annual Transparency Report

January 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026

Tube8 strives to create a safe environment for our users and creators. We have strict policies to prevent and respond to [child sexual abuse material](#) (CSAM), [non-consensual content](#) (NCC), and any other forms of illegal content or activity. We are proactive in working to prevent CSAM and NCC on our platform. These measures include only allowing verified content creators to upload to our platform, the use of [several tools and technologies](#), as well as human review by trained moderators prior to the publication of content to ensure that content adheres to our [Terms of Service](#), [Community Guidelines](#) and related policies. This process also includes verifying the identity and consent of **every** performer seen in user-generated content uploaded through our Model Program. The content available on Tube8 is exclusively sourced from Pornhub. All content on the platform is supplied solely by verified content creators.

All moderators review and assess content in a wide variety of languages and employ several tools to assess this content. Audio content is assessed by moderators who either use translation/transcription tools or who understand the spoken language in the content. In cases where the audio content cannot be understood, the content is rejected as we are unable to meaningfully evaluate potential compliance issues.



While we have implemented many safeguards to help prevent illegal content, if users believe that they have come across content that is illegal or otherwise violates our policies, the content can be reported by [flagging it](#) or via our [Content Removal Request](#) (CRR) form. In addition to flagging content, users can also flag comments or other users that may be in violation of our [Terms of Service](#). We also cooperate with law enforcement and provide an easy way for law enforcement and legal representatives to submit requests through our secure online portal.

We work with a number of organizations that specialize in the prevention and response to NCC and CSAM, which allows us to continue strengthening our policies and Trust and Safety efforts. During the reporting period, we continued to further our Trust and Safety efforts and can share the following updates:

Renewed Consent

As part of our commitment to ensure ongoing consent of all performers seen in content, we implemented the requirement for members of the Model Program to renew co-performer consent every two years. A model must provide a new consent form before new content of a co-performer whose consent was last verified 2 years before or more can be published.

Creator Appeals

In June, we deployed a formalized process for creators to appeal the removal of their content for Terms of Service violations. We plan to expand the appeals process for users to appeal the banning of their account for Terms of Service violations.

Content Uploads During January 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026

A total of 987,300 (987,300 videos and 0 photos) pieces of content were uploaded to Tube8 during the reporting period. All uploads reported for this period originated on the Pornhub network and were subsequently exported to Tube8. Of these uploads, 923,132 (923,132 videos and 0 photos) pieces of content were made available on Tube8. A portion of these uploads, as well as content uploaded prior to the reporting period were removed for violating our [Terms of Service](#).

Reported Potential Child Sexual Abuse Material

We have a [zero-tolerance policy](#) against underage content, as well as the exploitation of minors in any capacity.

Tube8 is against the creation and distribution of child sexual abuse material (CSAM), as well as the abuse and trafficking of children. CSAM is one of many examples of illegal content that is prohibited by our [Terms of Service](#) and related guidelines.

Potential child sexual abuse material that is detected through moderation efforts, including detection through various internal and external tools listed [here](#), or reported to us by our users and other external sources is removed and fingerprinted. Additionally, the uploader is permanently banned from our platforms and is reported to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children ([NCMEC](#)).

For the purposes of our [CSAM Policy](#) and our reporting to NCMEC, we deem a child to be a human, real or fictional, who is or appears to be below the age of 18. Any content that features a child engaged in sexually explicit conduct, lascivious or lewd exhibition is deemed potential CSAM for the purposes of our Child Sexual Abuse Material Policy.

In the first six months of 2026, we made 4 reports to NCMEC. These reports contained 4 pieces of content (4 videos and 0 photos) that were identified as potential CSAM. This content was uploaded by 4 user accounts. All of the 4 accounts were permanently banned on our platform, and no accounts were reinstated after being banned.

For all content removed and reported before being viewed on Tube8, the majority was detected through our moderation process.

The above figure shows the source of detection for all content that was removed prior to appearing live that was reported from January through June 2026.

Analysis: 100% of reported content that was identified before appearing on our platform was removed by our human moderators or during the audit process.

Of the content uploaded in the first six months of 2026 that was reported as potential CSAM after appearing on our platform, the majority was detected through our moderation and auditing processes.

Videos reported after appearing on our platform were viewed on an average of 205 times prior to removal, with a median number of views of 237. Videos were available for 5 days on average and a median of 8 days prior to initial removal.

The above figure shows the source of detection for all content that was removed after appearing live that was uploaded and reported from January through June 2026.

Analysis: For content removed and reported after appearing live on the platform, 100% of these removals were initiated due to internal moderation or audit processes.

Non-Consensual Content

We have a [zero-tolerance policy](#) against non-consensual content (NCC). When we identify or are made aware of the existence of non-consensual content on Tube8, we remove the content, fingerprint it to prevent re-upload, and ban the user in accordance with our [Terms of Service](#).

Our NCC policy includes the following violations:

- Non-Consensual Content – Act(s): Content which depicts activity for which an individual did not validly consent. A non-consensual act is one involving the application of force directly or indirectly without the consent of the other person to a sexual act.
- Non-Consensual Content – Recording(s): The recording of sexually explicit activity without the consent of the featured person.
- Non-Consensual Content – Distribution: The distribution of sexually explicit content without the featured person’s permission.

- **Non-Consensual Content – Manipulation:** This type of content depicts an individual’s likeness without their consent (including “deepfakes” or other forms of AI-generated or manipulated content).

We are steadfast in our commitment to protecting the safety of our users and the integrity of our platform; we oppose all forms of non-consensual content.

From January through June 2026, we removed 22 pieces of content (22 videos and 0 photos) for violating our [NCC policy](#). This content was uploaded by 9 user accounts. All of the 9 accounts were permanently banned on our platform, and no accounts were reinstated after being banned.

As part of our commitment to assisting victims of non-consensual content, we also proactively report incidents of non-consensual content where there is a suspected or apparent threat to life to the individual(s) involved. During this period, we did not report any content removed for NCC as it did not fall within our reporting criteria

For all content removed for violating our NCC policy before being viewed on Tube8, the majority was detected through our moderation and auditing processes.

The above figure shows the source of detection for all content that was removed prior to appearing live that was removed in the first six months of 2026.

Analysis: 100% of content that was identified and removed before appearing on our platform was removed by our human moderators or during the audit process.

Of the content uploaded in the first six months of 2026 that was removed for violating our NCC policy after being viewed on our platform, the majority were due to content removal requests.

Videos removed after appearing on our platform were viewed on an average of 90,603 times prior to removal, with a median number of views of 20,039. Videos were available for 52 days on average and a median of 39 days prior to initial removal.

The above figure shows the source of detection for content that was uploaded and removed after appearing live during the first six months of 2026.

Analysis: For content removed after appearing live on the platform, user-initiated removals accounted for 95.24% of these removals.
